## Statement of Evidence:

- 1873 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 14" Cedar N 88 E 20 links, 6" Fir N 64 W 8 links, 6" Fir S 63 W 15 links, and 24" Cedar S 60 E 18 links.
- 1924 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey reestablished this corner by proportional distance. No evidence of the original corner was found. An iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 7" Poplar N 41-00 E 140 links, 4" Birch S 42-30 E 23 links, 6" Birch S 79-30 W 53 links, and 6" Poplar N 49-15 W 39 links.
- 1963 U.S. Forest Service technician, J.H. Ekstrom, found the corner monumented with a U.S.G.L.O. brass cap monument. 7" Elm N 68 E 30.0', 8" Balsam S 8 E 10.8', and 9" Poplar S 59 W 22.1' new bearing trees were marked.

  A steel fence post was set near corner. In 1964 William Okerman, RLS No. 6807, filed a certificate of location with Cass County as per this information.
- 1987 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1987 Found brass cap monument in good condition up 12". Also found remains of one 1924 BT: 12" Birch snag with scar S 80 W 35.6 feet. Found two of the 1963 tie trees and retied as shown on this certificate.
