Statement of Evidence: S-N 1/64 Corner on East Line Section 1, T.141 N., R.28 W., 5th
(A.P. #1 Tract 1532 & A.P. #4 Tract 1533). P.M.

- 1918 US GEneral Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner with a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap. Corner falls in road-set 36" in ground. No bearing trees marked.
- 1972 US Forest Service personnel found remains of 1918 GLO survey and information documented in Forest Service record. No new monument set, as GLO monument was in good condition. The following bearings were marked: 8" W.Oak S 70°W 81.40', 5" W.Oak S 47°E 37.80', 6" W.Oak S 45°W 115.40', all blazed and scribed. 4"x4" Cedar Post WEST 15.10'. Willaim Okerman filed CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER.
- 1987 Walt Curo, under Forest Service contract, found GLO brass cap monument at surface of road and 1972 BT SE. Lowered monument 10" and marked new BT's. 14" Red Oak N 89°E 33.55', 6" Burr Oak N 23°E 42.10', 24" Red Oak S 81°W 57.25'. He files this certificate to update the 1972 certificate.
