

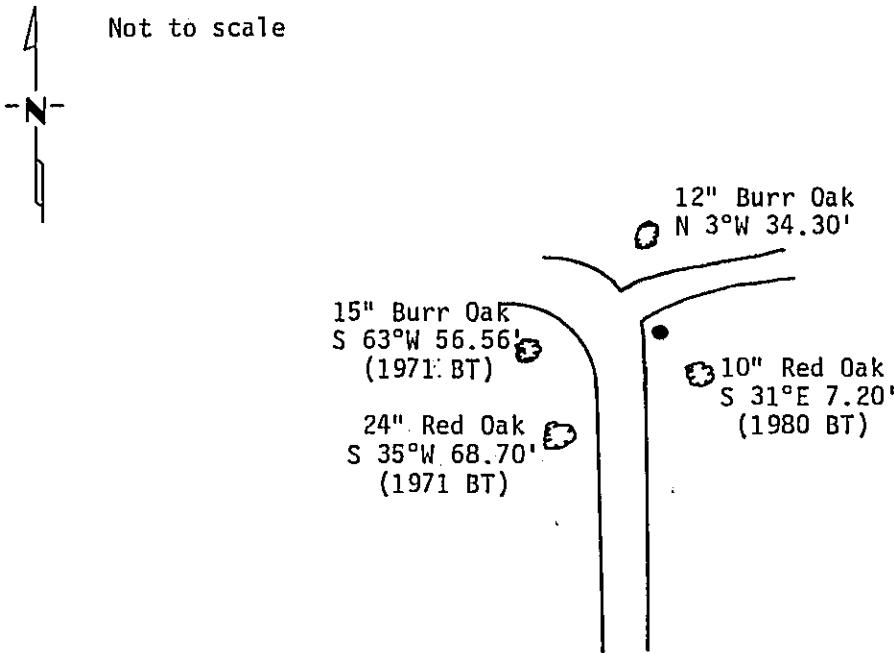

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner Section 3, T.141 N., R.28 W., 5th P.M.

- 1874 US General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing tree: 10" Oak S 80°W 150 lks.
- 1918 US General Land Office dependent resurvey found old Gov't BT and set a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap. The following new trees were marked: 12"W.Oak N 59½°E 124 lks., 6" Bl.Oak S 33°W 32 lks.
- 1972 R.F.Schneider plats TOWNLINE SHORES and shows iron pipe at corner.
- 1972 US Forest Service personnel found iron in good condition and marked two new BT's: 15" Oak S 40°W 69.1', 11" Oak S 64°W 56.7'. Both trees scribed "¼ S3 BT"
- 1980 US Forest Service personnel marked and scribed one new BT: 9" Red Oak S 27°E 7.28'
- 1987 Walt Curo, under contract with the US Forest Service, found 1" GLO brass cap monument 6" above ground. Corner is 10' east and 8' south of roads. Bearing trees marked as shown on front of this certificate.
