Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner Section 27, T.141 N., R.31 W., 5th P.M.

- 1873 US General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 5" Birch S 70 E 14 lks., 8" J.Pine stub N 71 W 17 lks.
- 1921 County Survey Record Book "C", page 460, shows a survey by E.B.Horst. He set the corner-a 2x48" I.M.
- 1922 County Resurvey plat in the Cass County Recorders Office cabinet "E", number 53, shows the corner as a 2x48" iron monument. Survey by E.B.Horst.
- 1959 Harold Curo found a 2x48" boiler flue and replaced it with a 2 3/4"x60" capped iron monument filled with concrete. He marked new BT's: 6" White Oak N 37-43 E 10.90', 5" W.Oak N 83-20 W 33.70', 7" Red Oak S 35 W 34.60'. He filed a Certificate of Location of Government Corner.
- 1980 US Forest Service personnel, Brama, Hare & Northe, found I.P. with brass cap and all 3 1959 BT's in good condition. Sign posts were set East & North of the I.P.
- 1987 Walt Curo, under Forest Service contract, found the I.P. and NW & SW 1959 BT's in good condition, NE BT is dead. Marked one new BT: 12" Burr Oak N 3 E 39.60'. I file this certificate to update the 1959 certificate.
