North Quarter Corner, Section 32, Township 140 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1870 the original government survey was done by Orville Smith.  $\Lambda$  wood post was set to mark the corner.

Two bearing trees witnessing said corner were marked, noted as follows: 7" black oak North 25 degrees East, 16 links 5" white birch South 33 degrees West, 18 links.

Around the middle 1940's W. J. Spain, Jr., RLS #2003, used this monument in the subdivision of Government Lot 5, 6, 7, 8 and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter for then land owner Foss. Current owner of Government Lot 8, Albert Foss (son), testified also of this fact and described Spain's services, as the Foss's helped Spain through the process of the survey.

In 1987 David Landecker, RLS #17008, surveyor with the firm of Landecker & Associates, Inc., found iron pipe monument used by Spain in the Foss survey and accepts this monument as the corner.
