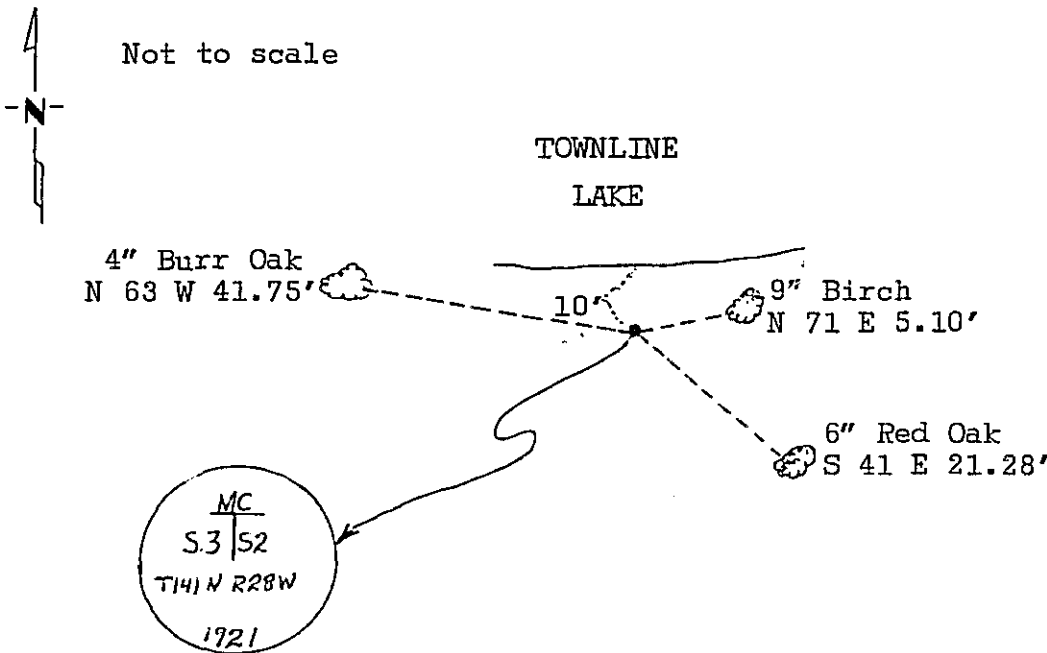

Statement of Evidence: Meander Corner #24, Sections 2&3, T.141 N., R.28 W.,  
5th P.M.

- 1874 US General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 7" Birch S 49 W 14 lks., 6" W.Pine S 52 E 90 lks.
- 1921 US General Land Office dependent resurvey found an old decayed stake and set a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap. The following bearings were marked: 6" Red Oak S 59  $\frac{1}{2}$  E 16 lks., 12" Birch N 35  $\frac{3}{4}$  W 27 lks.
- 1988 On March 7, Curo Surveying, under contract with the US Forest Service, found the brass cap monument up 29" in mound of rocks, 10' southerly of waters edge. Bearing trees marked as shown on front of this certificate.
