

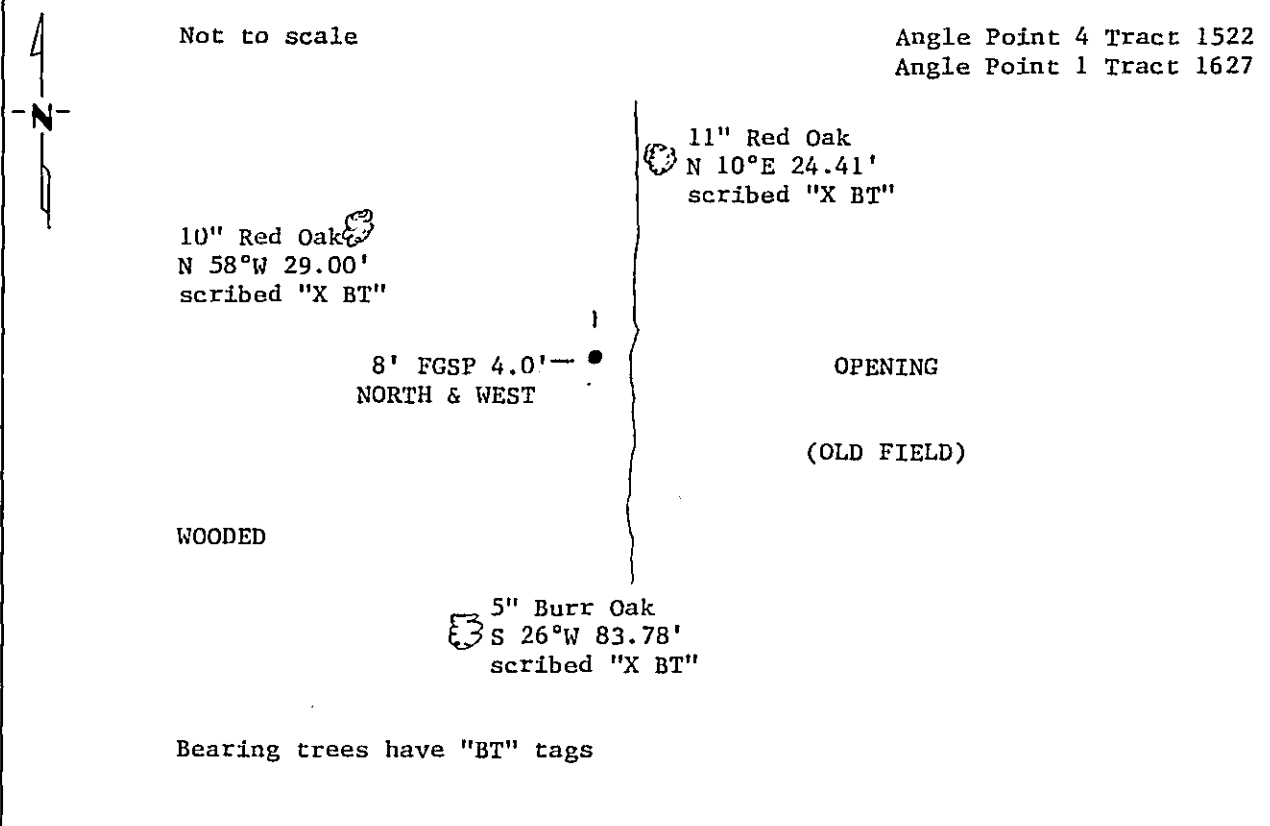

- 1918 US General Land Office dependent resurvey set a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap for this corner. No bearing trees were marked.
- 1987 On July 27, Terry Freeman,Cass County Surveyors Office and Curt Krause,US Forest Service found the GLO brass cap monument in good condition,up 8". Mark three bearing trees and set fiberglass sign posts NORTH 4.0' and WEST 4.0'. Chained GLO distance south and the distance checks well.
