- 1873 P. H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while subdividing Township 141 North, Range 30 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 7 inch Maple North 68 degrees West a distance of 21 links; and a 4 inch Poplar North 80 degrees East a distance of 29 links.
- 1965 U.S. Forest Service technician James Ekstrom found the corner monumented with a 2 lach iron pipe. Set a 2 inch by 5 foot iron pipe with bronze cap for corner. The following bearing trees were marked: a 17 inch Norway Pine North 54 degrees West a distance of 37.6 feet; and a 16 inch Norway Pine North 63 degrees East a distance of 31.2 feet.
- 1965 U.S. Forest Service Surveyor Bill Okerman, Licensed Land Surveyor Number 6807, filed corner certificate using 1965 information.
- 1968 U.S. Forest Service Surveyor Bill Okerman, Licensed Land Surveyor Number 6807, filed a corner certificate on February 19, with the Cass County Recorder as certificate Number 644, using the 1965 information.
- 1986 U.S. Forest Service crews set an aerial target over this corner position for determination of coordinate values through the use of GPS on the Chippewa South Boundary Project Cadastral Survey U.S. Project Number 53-6392-8-219. This target allowed for the search and location of this corner. 1965 bearing tree was cut off.
- 1988 on June 28 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew visited the corner and found the following evidence: a 2 inch iron pipe with brass cap up 18 inches with capped iron pipe, as previously used by the County, on west side; all 1965 bearing trees cut off. New bearing trees were marked as shown and steel sign post is in place as noted on front of this certificate.
