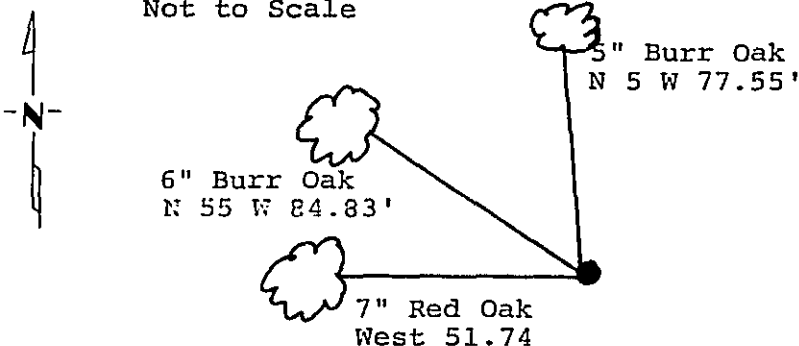


CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

1863 Johnson and Thornton, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, originally established this corner position while running the 10th Standard Parallel. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 12 inch Aspen North 75 degrees West a distance of 34 links; and a 7 inch Yellow Pine North 4 degrees East a distance of 34 links.

1965 U.S. Forest Service technician James Ekstrom found the corner monumented with a 2 inch iron pipe. He set a 2 inch by 5 foot iron pipe with bronze cap. New bearing trees were marked: a 6 inch Aspen North 46 degrees West a distance of 19.6 feet; and a 5 inch Maple North 53 degrees East a distance of 27.5 feet.

1971 U.S. Forest Service Surveyor Bill Okerman, Licensed Land Surveyor Number 6807, filed corner certificate on February 19, with the Cass County Recorder as certificate Number 626, using 1965 information.

1986 U.S. Forest Service crews set an aerial target over this corner position for determination of coordinate values through the use of GPS on the Chippewa South Boundary Project Cadastral Survey U.S. Project Number 53-6392-8-219. This target allowed for the search and location of this corner. Both 1965 bearing trees were cut off.

1988 on June 1 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew visited the corner and found the following evidence: 2 inch brass cap monument and capped iron as previously used by County in good condition. New bearing trees were marked as shown and steel sign post was set as noted on front of this certificate.
