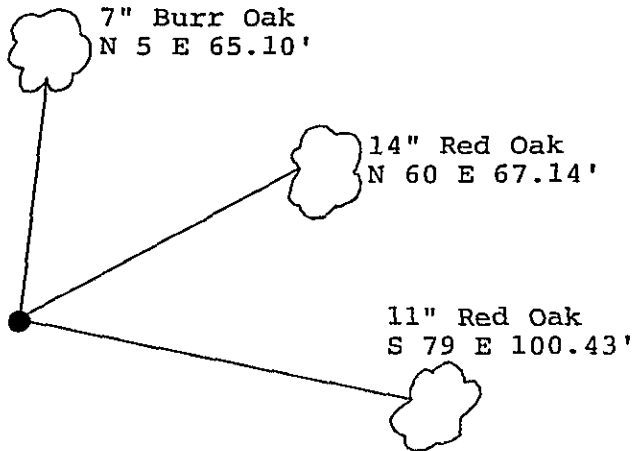
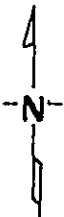

1871 George Stuntz, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while running the West line of Township 142 North, Range 31 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: an 8 inch Tamarack South 35 degrees West a distance of 12 links; and a 7 inch Tamarack South 30 degrees East a distance of 92 links.

1921 County Surveyor's Record Book C, page 473 shows survey by E.B. Horst. The notes indicate a 2 inch by 48 inch iron monument was set at the single proportion position between the Northwest corner of Section 18 and the West Quarter corner of Section 19. The notes do not indicate that any bearing trees were marked.

1921 County resurvey in County Recorder's Office file cabinet E number 59 shows survey by E.B. Horst. The notes indicate a 2 inch by 48 inch iron monument was found.

1988 United States Forest Service personnel traverse the West line of Township 142 North. They find the 2 inch iron pipe as set by Horst in 1921.

1990 Landecker & Associates, Inc. review the USFS notes. A new corner was computed by single proportion measurement between the Northwest corner of Section 18 and the West Quarter corner of Section 19 as recovered by the USFS in 1988. No evidence was found of the original survey at this new location. The corner was determined to be lost.

1991 on January 29, a Landecker & Associates, Inc. survey crew set a 5 foot aluminum rod with point, 3 foot stabilizer and aluminum cap at the single proportion position between the Northwest corner of Section 18 and the West Quarter corner of Section 19 in Tag Elder & Willow swamp. New bearing trees were marked as shown and steel sign posts set as noted on front of this certificate. The 2 inch iron pipe set by Horst in 1921 is northwest approximately 104 feet.
