

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

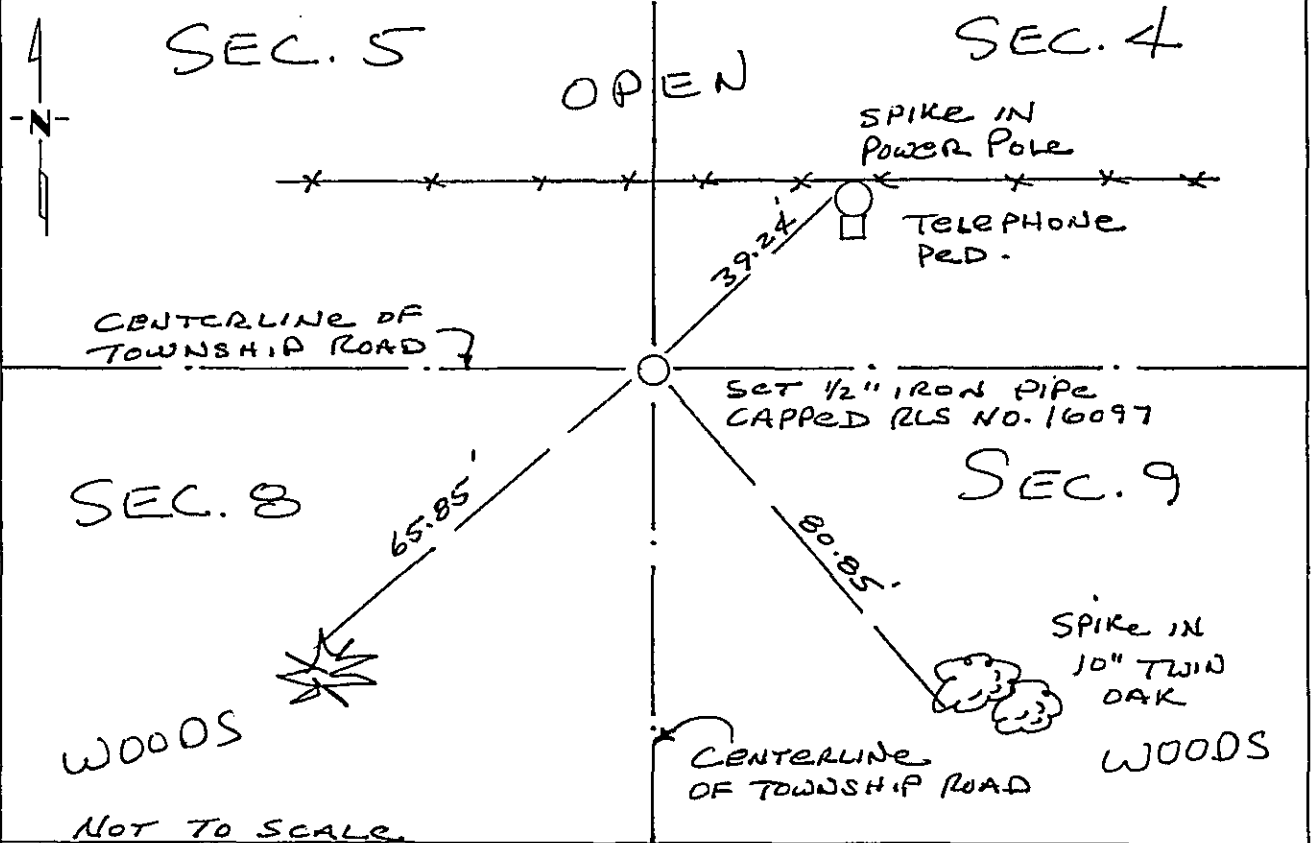
Northeast Corner of Section 8, Township 134, Range 32, 5th P.M.

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On March 14, 1992 DATE and a digging 4' X 4' to natural soil was done and nothing was found
 - left monument as found, lowered monument, removed monument (explain)
- On 3-14-92 DATE placed a 1/2" iron pipe monument capped RLS No. 16097 at centerline-centerline

Statement of Evidence:

The Northeast Corner of Section 8, Township 134, Range 32, 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota, was set in 1870, under the Public Land Survey as a post with 2 bearing trees. No evidence of the post or bearing trees was found.

A search of County records revealed no additional data.

In 1991 and 1992, while subdividing Section 6, Thomas P. Thiessen, RLS No. 16097, searched for the Northeast Corner of Section 8 at the centerline - centerline intersection of an east-west Township Road and a Township Road south. A 4' X 4' digging was made to natural soil with nothing found. A check of distance east, west, and north verifying this as the position for the Northeast Corner of Section 8. On Mar. 14, 1992, ~~A~~ 1/2 inch iron pipe capped RLS No. 16097 was placed down 0.5', more or less.
