The Plat of FIRST ADDITION TO JOHANNESSOHN LOTS, by Dean Anderson, RLS, shows an iron pipe at the quarter corner with a distance of 197.19' east along the section line

to an iron pipe at the NE corner of Lot 12 of said Plat.

1983 The DNR Bureau of Engineering found a 1 1/4" iron pipe at the quarter corner. A very old and burned 13" White Pine stump with a blaze on its SW side was found N. 56° E., 16.9' from the iron pipe. A 1" iron pipe was found at a distance of 197.20' easterly of the 1 1/4" pipe.

The 1 1/4" iron pipe was accepted as marking the quarter corner position.
