
CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Northeast Section Corner of Section 11, Township 142 North, Range 26 West, of the 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

July, 1997; Northern Lights Surveying and Mapping, Inc. monumented the section corner position arrived at by single proportioning between the section corner common to Sections 1, 2, 35, and 36, T.142N and T.143N, R.26W, and the section corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13, and 14, T.142N, R.26W. This unconventional method was adopted because it fit extensive General Land Office (G.L.O.) feature calls.

Statement of Evidence

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Northeast Corner Section 11, Township 142 North, Range 26 West, of the 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

November, 1872; General Land Office (G.L.O.) survey notes; Deputy Surveyor E.W. Griffin set a wooden post for the section corner and referenced it with the following:

10" Sugar (0.254m) 6" Fir (0.152m) 14" Birch (0.41m) 16" Aspen (0.41m) N54"W S53"E S77"W N41"E
17 Links (3.420m) 13 Links (2.615m) 30 Links (6.055m) 22 Links (4.426m)

1963; United States Department of Agriculture - Forest Service (U.S.D.A.-F.S.) Township Book T.142N., R.26W. Book #1, p.6; U.S.D.A.-F.S. survey technicians McDonald and Ekstrom chained east from the meander corner between Sections 2 and 11; conducted a search, but found no evidence of the section corner.

October, 1996; Mike Smith, party chief with Northern Lights Surveying and Mapping, Inc. cruised to, established, and conducted a Global Positioning System (G.P.S.) session on two search points. A preliminary search recovered no evidence of the G.LO. survey. The area has been logged.

July 22, 1997; Northern Lights Surveying and Mapping, Inc. crew of Foster and Berg searched, and monumented the section corner position arrived at by single-proportioning between the section corner common to Sections 1, 2, 35, and 36, T.142N., T.143N., R.26W., and the section corner common to sections 11, 12, 13, and 14, T.142N., R.26W. The crew set a 1.219m long, 0.051m diameter galvanized steel pipe with a stamped brass cap, with the following references:



Corner Methodology

The section corner common to sections 1, 2, 11, & 12 was positioned by way of single proportionate measurement between the section corner common to sections 1, 2, 35, & 36, T142 & 143N, R26W and the section corner common to sections 11, 12, 13, & 14, T142N, R26W. Although this method is unconventional for an interior section corner, it was the only method that closely fit extensive General Land Office (G.L.O.) feature calls. During the fall of 1996 and the winter of 1996–1997, Northern Lights Surveying & Mapping Inc. mapped the natural features called out in the G.L.O. notes. Using conventional surveying as well as mapping the features using an ARC-INFO driven digital orthophotoquad of the project area, all of the key features were integrated into Northern Lights' working drawing.

As no conclusive G.L.O. or subsequent evidence of the section corner in question was recovered in the field, an analysis of the feature calls was used to assist in determining its position. A comparison was made of where the features fell in relation to 1.) a corner position based upon three point control, and 2.) a corner position based upon single proportionate measurement. The results are as follows:

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Northeast corner Section 11, Township 142 North, Range 26 West, of the 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

From this analysis, it is clear that the single proportioned position, in comparison, fits the feature calls better than the three point control position. Being that there was no collateral evidence to the contrary and being that the N/S lines were inherently run better than the E/W lines within Slater Township, it was Northern Lights' conclusion to use a single proportioned position for the section corner.
