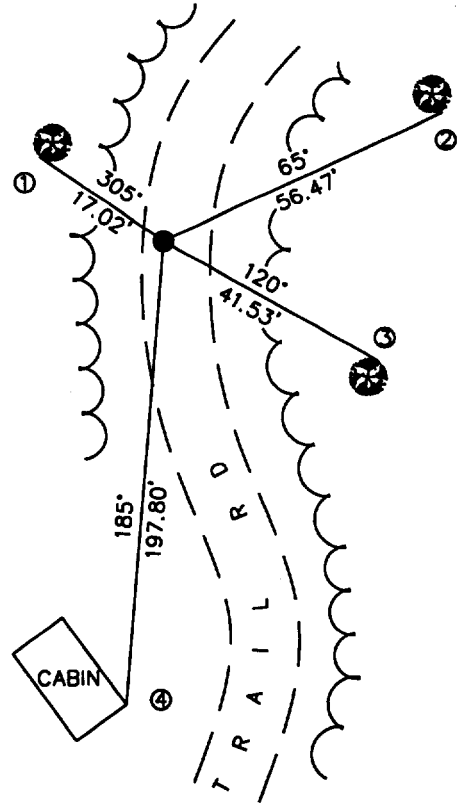

**East Quarter Corner Section 10, Township 140 North, Range 28 West**

1870 The US General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, show this corner to be marked with a post and the following bearing trees were marked:

Poplar 6" S10° E 75 links (49.5')  
Birch 12" S 15° W 10 links (6.6')

1919 Ben Clark found a 3" x 36" Oak post and the Govt. B.T: 12" W. Birch S15W 10 links. He set a 2" x 48" iron monument and took the following ties:

Maple 8" N 22°W 16.7'  
Oak 4" S 25°E 15.6'

1941 Civilian Conservation Corp. set approximate quarter corner 2640' from the south .

2000 In March, the DNR survey crew searched and found a 2" x 21" iron pipe laying down with the scribing of "1/4 S" on the side. The bottom portion of the pipe was found 10' away in the ground and in good condition. This pipe is identical to the other Clark iron pipes that we found in the area. A 3/4" x 24" iron rebar was set inside the pipe and flush with the ground. The iron pipe was accepted as marking the original government corner.

Northeast Corner Section 10 - N 01°05'09"E 2647.06'  
East Quarter Corner Section 11 - N 89°57'24"E 5037.92'
