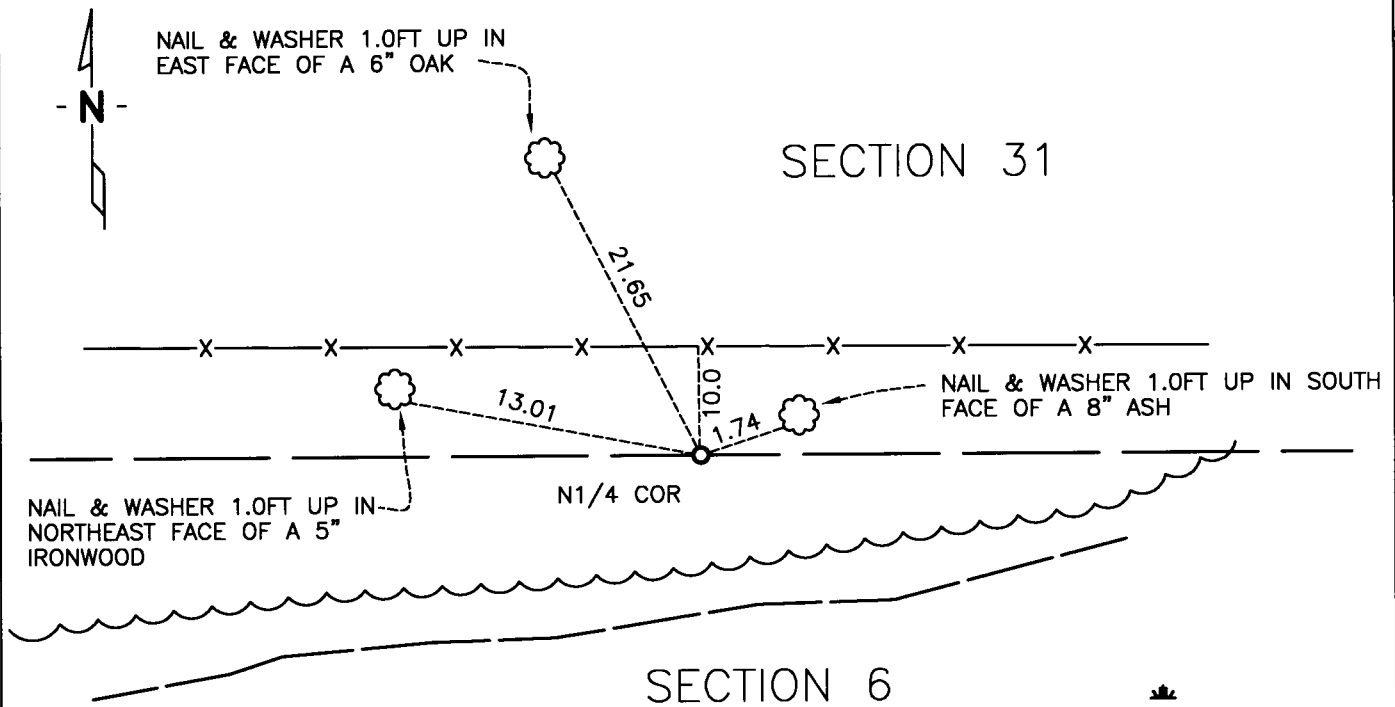

Statement of Evidence:**North Quarter Corner of Section 6, Township 134 North, Range 30 West**

April 1858 E.N. Darling GLO Deputy Surveyor set a wood post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

7" White Maple S48°W 25 links (16.50 feet)
7" White Oak N52°E 15 links (9.90 feet)

April 1905 Town road survey of the Pillager and Pine River Road, Cass County Road Calender Book, Page 42, on file at the CCSO.

Feb. 2009 B. Hippen CCSO technician, records of the CCSO, found a 24 inch White Oak stump with a double scar on the Southwest side, these scars begin 3 inches from the center. There is a depression S52°W 10 feet from this stump.

Dec. Craig E. Johnson, LS, CFedS, another search of the area found the 24" White Oak stump with scars, this old stump could be the original bearing tree, however not enough evidence of markings remain to result in a definitive answer. Johnson set a 1/2 iron pipe capped No. 44530. The corner was established by single proportion, prorating the Government chainage between the SW corner of section 31 and the computed position for the SE corner of Section 32 which falls in a lake, the position for the SE corner of Section 32 was computed by K.L.D Surveying of Brainerd during a Nov. 2005 survey in Section 33, The position for Johnson's set corner was also corrected for latitudinal curve. The 24" White Oak stump falls 10.00 feet northwesterly of the set corner.
