## STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

Northeast Corner of Section 12, Township 143 North, Range 30 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1873, P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a wood post inplace to mark the location of this corner and established bearing trees as follows: an 8" Black Ash, N39°E 39 links; a 14" Yellow Birch, N43°W 24 links; an 18" Yellow Birch, S40°W 28 links; and a 14" Lind, S33°E 46 links.

1900, U.S. Army Corp of Engineers map for the Leech Lake Reservoir shows corner found by surveyor Horace Dunaway. Copy of map on file in Cass County Survey Department.

**In 1924**, Earl G. Harrington, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, found the northeast, southwest, and northwest original BTs. He set a 2x36" iron pipe with a brass cap and established four new bearing trees as follows: an 8" Cedar, N19°30'E 41 links; a 12" Cedar, S65°15'E 41 links; a 10" Maple, S3°15'W 85 links; and an 8" Cedar, N51°30'W 24 links. Information on file in the Cass County Surveyors office.

On June 23, 2011, a Northern Engineering & Consulting survey crew found a 2" iron pipe with a 2-1/2" GLO brass cap lying on the ground. Reset monument from stumps of three of the 1924 BT's. They marked four new bearing trees as shown on the front page of this certificate. Brass cap is accepted as a perpetuation of the original corner.
