## **Statement of Evidence**

## Northeast corner, Section 27, Township 139 North, Range 28 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota

1864 – Original U.S. Government Survey establishing this corner was performed. A wood post was set marking its location from which the following witnesses were established:

8" W. Pine N 32° W 139 links 7" W. Pine S 70° W 180 links

1919 - Ben Clark found nail in post as recorded in Survey Record 434, County Survey Record Book C, page 308. Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ' x 3" iron pipe with cap as recorded in said Book, pages 311-312 with the following witness:

14" N. Pine N 81°30' E 345.7 feet

1921 – County Resurveys prepared by Ben Clark and filed in the Cass County Recorder's Office as Document Numbers 69794 and 69796 indicate an iron monument.

1939 – Civilian Conservation Corps found a 2" iron pipe with cap as recorded in Washburn Lake Book 13, page 30 on file with Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, Outing Ofice.
