1864 – Original U.S. Government Survey establishing this corner was performed. A wood post was set marking its location from which the following witnesses were established:

6" Aspen N 50° W 5 links 10" Aspen S 30° E 6 links

1919 - Ben Clark set 2 ½" x 4' iron pipe as recorded in Survey Record 434, County Survey Record Book C, page 339. No witnesses were recorded.

1921 – County Resurvey prepared by Ben Clark and filed in the Cass County Recorder's Office as Document Number 69794 indicates an iron monument set at midpoint of north line of section.
