Statement of Evidence

John Greene, Deputy County Surveyor, Survey Record Number 551, Book D, page 195, on file in the CCSO, indicates finding the corner and a set a new stake.

1936 CCC Washburn Lake field book no. 7, page 3, on file at the DNR office in Brainerd show CCC personnel set a temp corner 40 chains south of the NE 23. A 4" stake was found 73 ½ links north and 12 ½ links west. Corner position was witnessed by:

KLJ field crews searched the area and found nothing. This corner was set lost by single proportion between the NE 23 and the NE 26.
