## Statement of Evidence

## Northeast corner of Section 21, Township 139 North, Range 28 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

Johnson and Thornton, General Land Office Deputy Surveyors, notes for the subdivision of Township 139 North, April 1864 Range 28 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

8" J. Pine N 10° F

5" Tam. N 27° W 275 links (183.3 feet) 113 links (75.3 feet) 8" J. Pine S 42° W 9" W. Pine S 68° E 132 links (88 feet) 250 links (166.6 feet) The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the

Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

J.W. Curo, LS 1428, in a survey for Beals and Burfield, Curo Field Book 85, page 218 on file at the CCHD/SO. Oct. states "found old stake in meadow which we took for the NW cor 22-139-28 but did not mark it up."....We did not 1908 find any of the BT's tho if we had looked hard we probably could. An old stake set by some one must be mighty close to the right spot as the slope of the meadow would not allow it to go much of any place else..".

B. Clark, LS 231, CCSO, Survey Record Number 434, Book C, page 335, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "An iron Aug. pipe 2 ½ feet long 3 in. diam. Oak post wedge shape, point inside the iron pipe. Drove the same in ground 3 feet. 1919 Stamped the cap on pipe 15-16-21-22. Found old white pine down marked B.T." and lists recovered original bearing trees as follows:

9" W. Pine S 66° E 132 links (88 feet) 8" J. Pine S 40° W 250 links (166.6 feet)

8" J. Pine N 10° E 275 links (183.3 feet)

Marked the following new accessory: 22" W. Pine N 10° W 31.2 feet

"A mound of stone around iron pipe. No other trees around."

B.F. Clark, LS 231, County Resurvey Plat, recorded in the Cass County Recorders Office, as Document Number Dec. 1921 69798, indicates an iron monument.

Civilian Conservation Corps personnel, Washburn Lake Book 12, Page 18 on file in the Minnesota Department of 1939 Natural Resources Outing office, indicates, Found 2" I.P. w/cap 5283 from E., and Bk. 12, P. 20 indicates at 5280' from W. Offset 280' N to 2" I.P. w/cap. Found W. Pine 22" N 10 1/2° W 234'.

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found a 2.25 inch outside diameter iron pipe with a stamped Sept. 2004 plumbers cap, up 0.8 foot, in open marsh, north edge of beaver channel and witnessed as follows: 5" Burr Oak N 10° W 119.44 feet 6" Maple N 20° F 248.80 feet

The monument, together with the recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument set in 1919 by B. Clark and recovered by the CCHD/SO in 2004 is a correct perpetuation of the original corner.
