## Statement of Evidence

## East Quarter corner Section 13, Township 139 North, Range 29 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

Geo. Wright, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor, notes for the subdivision of Township 139 North, Aug. 1865

Range 29 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

4" Tamarack N 79° W 4" Tamarack S 75° E 24 links (15.84 feet) 28 links (18.48 feet) The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

B.F. Clark, LS 231, Deputy County Surveyor, Survey Record No. 434, Book C, page 327, on file in the CCHD/SO Oct. states they ran north "At 5274 ft. found a Tam. Post 4 ft. long 4 in. Then search for witness trees and found 2 Tam. 1919 Posts marked ¼ S. with a Surveyor marking iron and 2 down Tam. In the marsh." He lists these as the GLO witness trees and "being satisfied this is the old gov't ¼ S. corner on west side S. 18. I set an iron pipe with wooden point in side and drove the same in the ground 6 ft. Then made 2 new witness trees":

5" Tamarack S 49° W 19.5 feet 5" Tamarack N 38° E 93 feet

March. B.F. Clark, LS 231, County Resurvey Plat, on file in the Cass County Recorders Office, as Document Number 1922 69797, indicates Iron Monument at the subject corner.

Jan. C.J. Hendershott, LS 45353, notes on file in the Northern Engineering & Consulting, (formerly Landecker & 2008 Assoc.) Walker Office, found a 2 inch iron pipe at the 1919 position.

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found a 2 inch outside diameter iron pipe, up 3.0 feet, in Dec. 2014

Tamarack swamp and witnessed as follows: 4" Tamarack S 21° E 16.18 feet

5" Tamarack S 80° W 17.40 feet 5" Tamarack N 18° E 17.30 feet

The recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by the CCHD/SO in 2014 is the correct perpetuation of this corner.
