## **Statement of Evidence**

East quarter corner, Section 12, Township 140 North, Range 26 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota

1864 – Original U.S. Government Survey establishing this corner was performed. A wood post was set marking its location from which the following witnesses were established:

7" Fir	N 24° E	16 links
8" Cedar	N 53° W	28 links

1916 – Alois Nowak, in County Survey Record Book B, pages 328-333, and in Curo Book 55, pages 61 and 76, denotes the original fir bearing tree has disappeared. Finds the cedar stump B.T., from which he sets by original bearing and distance a 3x3 birch post as the true corner and establishes two additional witnesses:

18" W. Pine stump	N 48° W	18.70 feet
20" W. Pine stump	NORTH	23 feet

1937 – CCC-Washburn Lake field book 1, page 39; field book 3, page 70; field book 4, page 30 all indicate an existing 2" iron pipe in place in township road.

1998 – CCSO staff found a ½" iron pipe lying 2 feet south of centerline of a township road. Established the following witnesses:

7" Tri. Ash	S 50° E	33.05 feet
8" Twin Maple	S 36° W	32.25 feet
12" Balsam	S 75° W	69.89 feet
6" Ash	N 38° E	80.75 feet

<sup>\*</sup> double headed nails were set in each tree

2014 – Patrick Trottier, PLS 41002, found and accepted as corner a ½" iron pipe. Found the SE and both SW witnesses from 1998.
