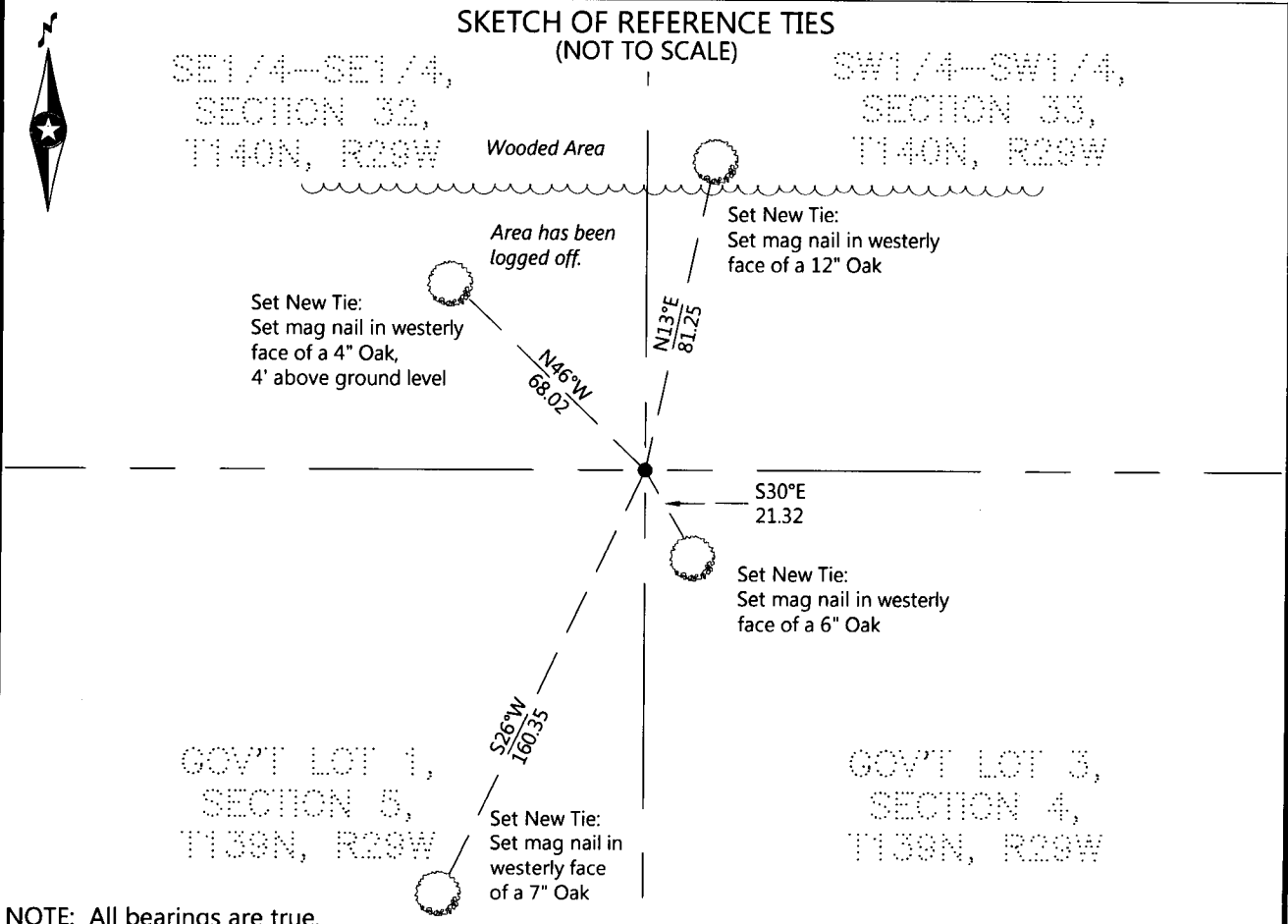

STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

Northeast Corner of Section 5, Township 139 North, Range 29 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1865, George B. Wright and Thomas B. Walker, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, set a wood post to mark the corner location and established bearing trees as follows: a 22" White Pine S 24° E 25 links; a 28" White Pine S 78° W 79 links; and a 24" Norway Pine N 31° E 155 links.
Record on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, MN and copies filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO).

In 1934, John Curo, County Surveyor, RLS 1428, in Curo Book 226, page 120-121, shows that he found the SE & SW original BT stumps. He set a 2"x30" iron pipe.
Information on file in the CCHD/SO.

In 1942, Cass County Surveyor's Record 611, Book D, pages 328-329, shows a survey by John Curo. He found an old White Pine stump S 26° E 93.2 feet and marked new trees: a 16" Oak N 48° E 138.3 feet; an 8" Poplar S 78° W 31.3 feet; and a 6" Poplar N 41° W 150.0 feet.
Information on file in the CCHD/SO.

In 1983, Terry L. Freeman, Cass County survey technician and Larry Olson, Cass County forester, found a 1" iron pipe up 1 foot and BT's with existing BT tags in lower blaze: a triple 4"-12" Red Oak S 32° E 9.90 feet; a quad 5"-7" Red Oak S 77° W 36.80 feet; a twin 9" Red Oak N 17° W 28.4 feet; and a triple 6" Birch N 36° E 5.43 feet.

On May 7, 2014, a Northern Engineering & Consulting survey crew found a 1" iron pipe up 3". They marked 4 new ties as shown on the front of this certificate. I accept the found monument as a perpetuation of the original corner.
