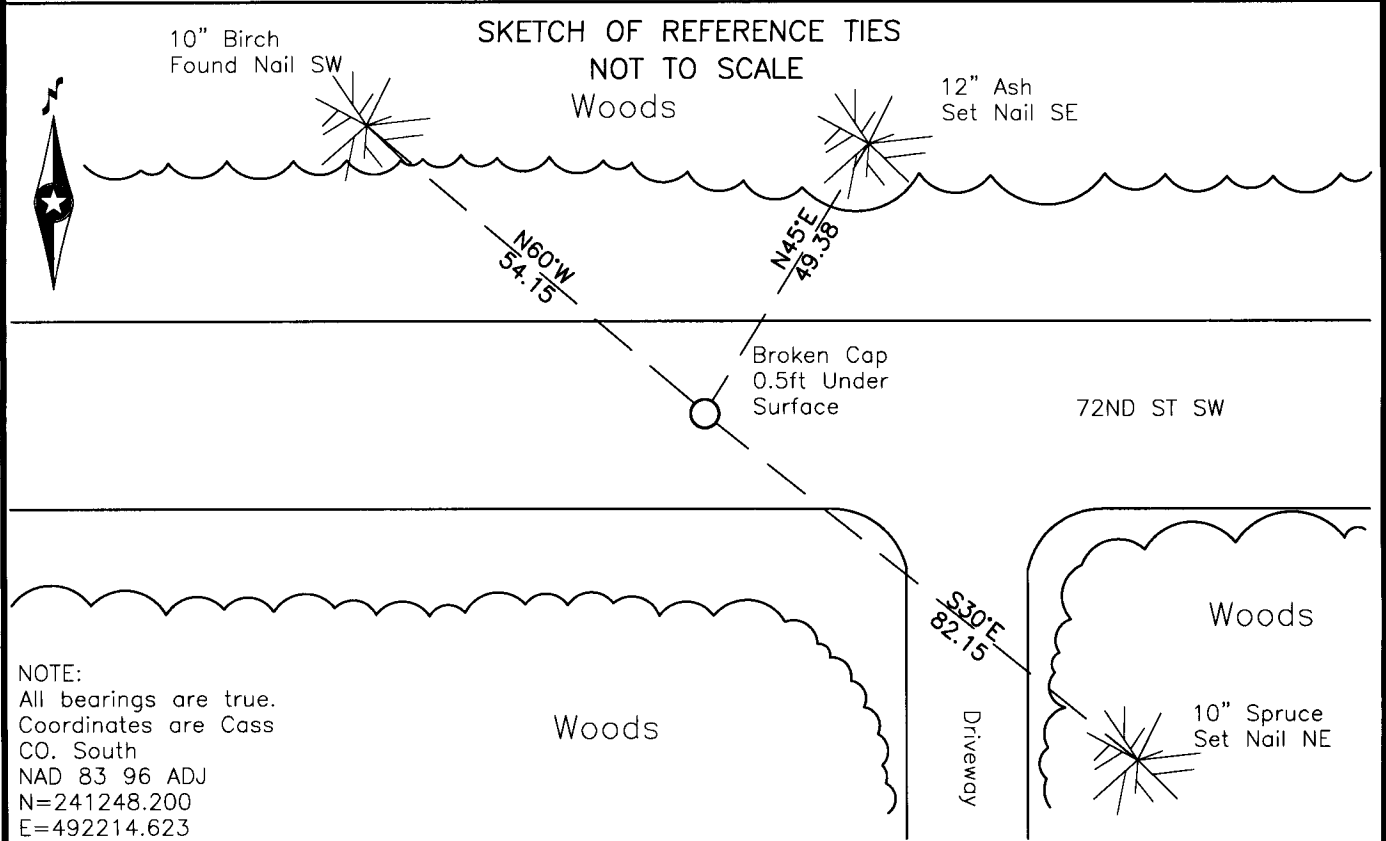

6" Tamarack	N 20° W	22 links
6" Tamarack	S 41° E	14 links
6" Spruce	N 2° E	19 links
5" Fir	S 35° W	16 links

1914 Cass County Survey Record Book "B" P. 57-61 and Curo book 094, page 126-127, F.A. Donner set iron pipe at corner from existing bearing trees. The following additional bearing trees were established at this time:

8" Balsam	S 6° 42' E	112.20 ft.
