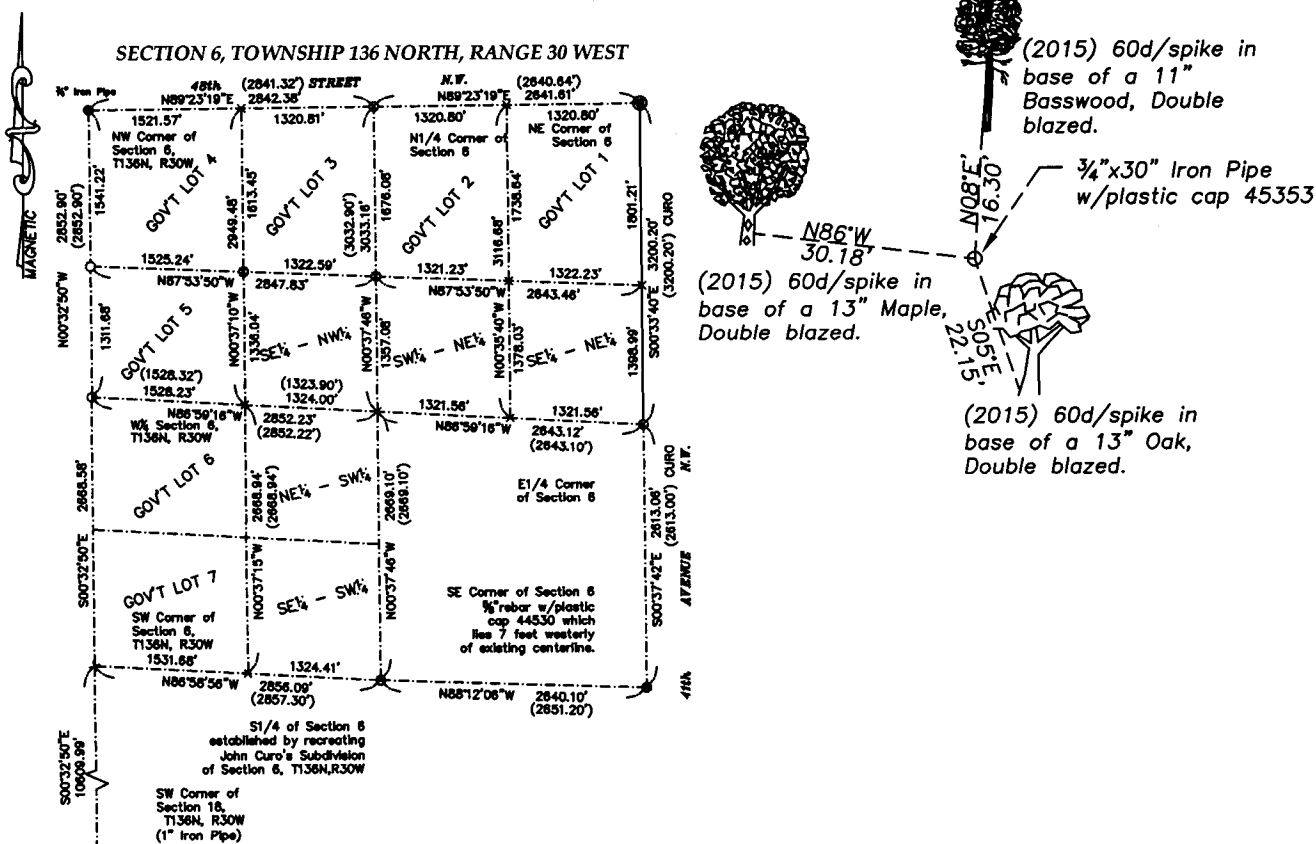

**STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE:** Quarter Corner common to Sections 6 and 7, Township 136 North, Range 30 West, of the 5th Principal Meridian.

1870; This corner was originally established by Richard Cronk, Deputy Surveyor under contract to the General Land Office (GLO), now the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). A copy of the plat of this township and hand copied field notes are on file in the Cass County Surveyor's Office. These Field notes indicate a wood post was set to mark this corner position, which was witnessed by:

W. Birch,	8",	N50°E,	25 lks.,	16.50 feet;
W. Birch,	9",	S10°E,	12 lks.,	7.92 feet:

1908; (Dec.) Cass County Survey Record Book "B", Pages 140 – 157, these note states that John W. Curo, Licensed Surveyor. While performing a Subdivision 6 for a private party, John W. Curo recovers both Government BT Birches still standing and set a new post. This corner position was witnessed by the following:

Gov't,	W. Birch,	9",	S10°E,	12 lks.,	7.92 feet:

1908; (Dec.) Curo's Field Book 85, page 260. These note states the same information as what is stated in the County Survey Record "B", pages 140-157, notes.

1911; Township Road Order show no survey.

2014; (Nov) I Corey J. Hendershott, L.S. 45353, Eagle Eye Data Services search for 1.5 hours for the remains of the Gov't Birches and John W. Curo's 1908 post with no luck. So I set a ¾"x 30" Iron Pipe with plastic cap 45353 at an "**Obliterated Position**", at John W. Curo's record distance of 5702.00 feet southerly on the N-S Quarter line of Section 6 for Latitudinal control and using the previously established West and East Quarter corner of Section 6 for Longitudinal control. This corner position was witnessed as shown on the face of this document.

**I feel this is best method of reestablishing the GLO position.**
