Circa W. Buckler, LS 9672, Field notes for Section 30, copy on file in the CCHD/SO, indicates Set 1/2" iron at the

1986 subject corner.

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found a spike, down 0.3 foot, on centerline of County Road Feb.

2003 #58 centerline of Chenevert's Road, located with the Global Positioning System (GPS).

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, prior to reconstruction on County Road #58, found a 1 inch June outside diameter iron pipe, down 0.4 foot, below bituminous surface, 6 feet, more or less, south of centerline of County Road #58 and 2 feet, more or less, west of centerline of Chenevert's Road, this agrees favorably with the

recovered North 1/4 corner and West 1/16 of Section 30, projected East. Removed pipe prior to road construction and witnessed as follows:

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, after reconstruction on County Road #58, set an aluminum Cass Sept. 2015 County monument at the recovered iron pipe position, down 0.05 foot, 5 feet, more or less, south of the new

centerline and placed the recovered iron pipe, adjacent on the west side.

The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered in 2015 by the CCHD/SO, is the accepted location of this corner.
