In 2020, Northwestern Surveying and Engineering, Inc., a private Land Surveying and Engineering firm, was conducting cadastral surveying in this area. After research and review of historic documents and records a survey crew searched for evidence of this position.

On 8/18/2020 a crew searched and found no evidence of this corner. A $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron rebar with plastic cap stamped "Stang 52591" was set using lost methods. New ties were taken as shown on the previous page.
