## NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27 TOWNSHIP 138 NORTH, RANGE 32 WEST OF THE 5<sup>TH</sup> PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

In 1870, the original Government Surveyor (Black) set a post in place to mark the location of this Public Land Survey Corner with the following bearing trees:

- 15" Norway Pine, North 40 degrees East, 33 links
- 16" Norway Pine, North 10 degrees West, 23 links
- 15" Norway Pine, South 38 degrees West, 41 links

Information on file in the MN Historical Society, St. Paul, MN and copies on file at the Cass County Highway Dept./ Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO)

In 1912, County Surveyor, John Curo was conducting survey work in this area. In his notes he states that he found a stake and two B.T's that were set by Usher and replaced it with an 8x8x36" concrete post. Information on file at the CCHD/SO (Surveyor Record Book "A", pg. 415-417 and Cass Book "C", pg. 402)

In 2020, Northwestern Surveying and Engineering, Inc., a private Land Surveying and Engineering firm, was conducting cadastral surveying in this area. After research and review of historic documents and records a survey crew searched for evidence of this position. No evidence of the corner or its accessories were found.

On 5/28/2020 a crew set a magnetic nail in the centerline of Highway No. 64 using obliterated methods. The centerline of Highway No. 64 was used to determine the East/West position of this corner. The centerline of 16<sup>th</sup> Street along with a fence line to the East was used to determine the North/South position of this corner. No other information was found to aid in determining the position of this corner. New ties were made as shown on the previous page.
