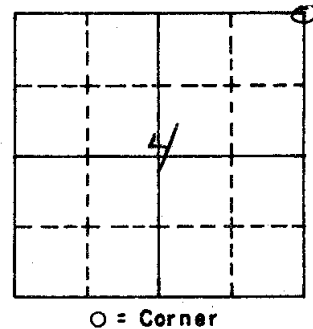

Power pole S 55 E 53.25'; Corner of fence
