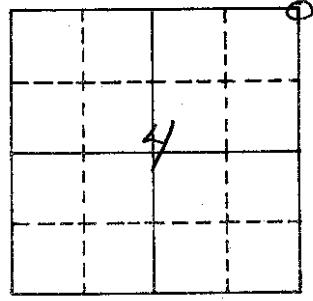


T. 133 R. 32 M. 5TH Coordinates: X NE 4 Y
