Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall make its Award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

Whereas, Upon the petition of Leas legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate

under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be opened; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who

forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed Board of Assessors is set forth

and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the corner of Section 33-34, Town 134 N-4, Range 133, R. 31, and Section 33-34, Town 134 N-4, Range 133, R. 31, on Section line between Section 33 and 34 in Town 134 N-4, Range 133, R. 31, and terminating at the corner of Section 34-35, Range 134-35, Town 134 N-4, Range 133, R. 31,

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 8 day of April 1913, at the N. W. corner Section 37, 133 R. 31

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the granting the same, and being of opinion that such Board

was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to grant said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith

accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of Section 33-34, Town 133 N-4, Range 134-35, and terminating at the corner of Section 33-34, Town 133 N-4, Range 133, R. 31, and the corner of Section 33-34, Town 134 N-4, Range 133, R. 31,
