Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall make its Award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the Road Order with the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. If no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

State of Minnesota, County of Coass Town of Meadow Brook SS:

Whereas, Upon the petition of Eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be Vacated; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed is set forth

and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at a point on section line east from the S W Corner of section 6 and N W Corner of section 7 Where jog in Road starts of section line and goes to a point where said jog in Road comes back on to section line between section 6 and section 7 in said Town of Meadow Brook being Town 135 R 31

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1924, at H. O. Block in the forenoon at Leander

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such road, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the Vacating the same, and being of opinion that such Vacating said Road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to Vacate said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby Vacated and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road Vacated rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
