The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not soon, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Moose Lake ss: Meadow Brook

Whereas, Upon the petition of twelve legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out & established; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed route is set forth

and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the section corner lying between sections 33 & 34 Twp 136 Range 31 and sections 3 & 4 Twp 135 Range 31 the centre line of road to follow in a general easterly direction the course of and to coincide with the section line lying between section 34 & 35 Twp 136 Range 31 and sections 3 & 3 Twp 135 Range 31 to the section corner lying between sections 35 & 36 Twp 136 Range 31 and sections 1 & 2 Twp 135 Range 31 and terminating thereat

The road to be of the width of four rods that is two rods on each side of said section line

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 10th day of July 1913, at the section corner lying between sections 33 & 34 Twp 136 Range 31 and section 2 3 & 4 Twp 135 Range 31

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out and establishment

of the same, and being of opinion that such laying out and establishing was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out and establish said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out and established is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

at the section corner lying between sections 33 & 34 Twp 136 Range 31 and section 3 & 4 Twp 135 Range 31 the centre line of road following in a general easterly direction coinciding with the section line lying between sections 34 & 35 Twp 136 Range 31 and sections 3 & 3 Twp 135 Range 31 to the section corner lying between sections 35 & 36 Twp 136 Range 31 and sections 1 & 2 Twp 135 Range 31 and terminating thereat

The width of said road shall be and is four rods that is two rods on either side of said section line

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road of four rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Moore Lake and Meadows Brook SS:

Whereas, A road was laid out and established on the 10th day of July 1912, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Moore Lake and Meadows Brook on the petition of twelve legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said road, which said road is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and,

Whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
