 The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Walden SS:

Whereas, Upon the petition of mine legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be land out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the south east corner of Dec. 18 and running west between Dec. 18 and Dec. 19 to the south west corner of Dec. 18 and 137 Range 30.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days hereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 20 day of May 1922, at East end of proposed new road

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out and establishing the same, and being of opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so land out is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

at the south east corner of Dec. 18 and running west between Dec. 18 and Dec. 19 to the south west corner of Dec 18 and 137 Range 30.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby land out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road four (4) rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
