Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall make its Award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk.  
The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

Whereas, Upon the petition of Price (9) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be Leitch Street; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed Leitch Street is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the North east corner of Section

four (4) on Township line of Towns One hundred and thirty eight (138) and One hundred and thirty nine (139) north of Range twenty nine (29) West, Township numbering west on the north side of sections four (4) five (5) and six (6), to the North west corner of section six (6) in town one hundred and thirty eight and on the south line of sections thirty three (33) thirty two (32) and thirty one (31) to the southeast corner of section thirty one (31) in town one hundred and thirty nine (39) then to corner with One River and thence down line road

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1910, at Leitch Street, Plainfield, Minnesota

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the beginning of Leitch Street the same, and being of opinion that such beginning was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so shown is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

at the corner of Section 31 Township 139 Range 29, Thence running as follows, with a variation of segments and minutes: Thence running east on 5th of range line 475 feet, thence along the several north end of Lake Station intersecting 5th of range at a point 600 feet east of N. E. Co. No. 28, thence running east on line to the SE corner of Sec 33.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby Leitch Street and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public highway thence (4) rods wide the said description above given being the center of said road.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Towns of Anta Lake & Pine River SS:

Whereas, A road was laid out on Anta Lake on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1912, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Anta Lake & Pine River on the petition of Prine & Co legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said road, which said road is is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and

Whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out said opening up said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
