But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

Whereas, Upon the petition of Thirteen legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the ~~road~~ <sup>Cartway</sup> proposed in said petition to be Layed out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed Cartway is set forth

and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning At the N.W. corner of  
Lot 4 Sec 32 Town 143 range 31 thence  
running west on 1/16 line between Lot 3 and  
the S. E. q of S. 34 of said sec. crossing  
the Great Northern Ry track and then  
connecting with the Township road running  
north from this point along the right  
of way of said railway

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 7 day of June 1919, at The Welsh school house

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the Proposed cartway the same, and being of opinion that such cartway was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit: Beginning
