Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall make its Award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

Whereas, A road was laid out between W. E. of W. W. and W. W. of W. E. on the 19 day of

June A. D. 1926, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Pipe Bay on the petition of

mine legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the

United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said road, which said road temporary cartway is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us and

Whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out said Temp. Cartway said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right, taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
