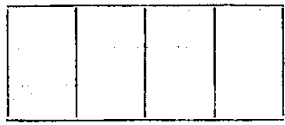

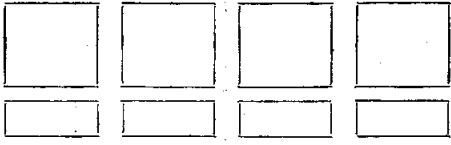
DIAGONAL POSITION
