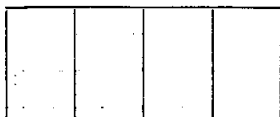
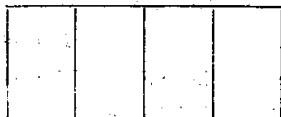

CARDINAL POSITION

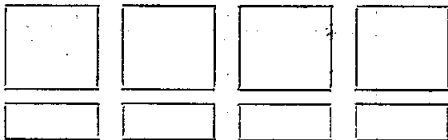

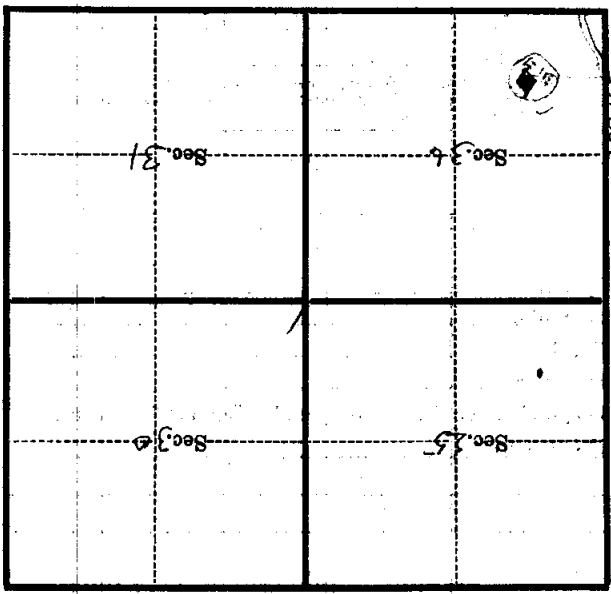
