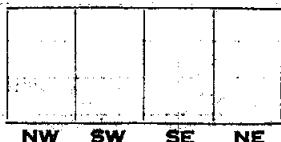

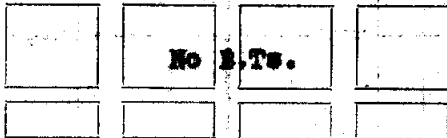
DIAGONAL POSITION

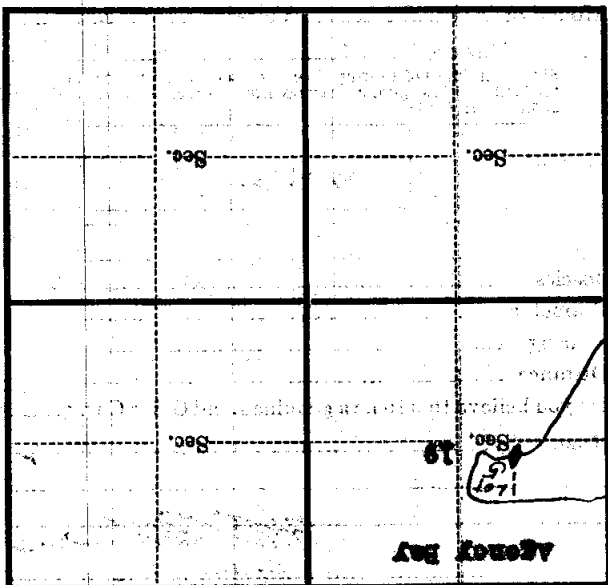
