10, and 9

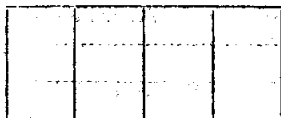
Corner consists of a sq. stake (rot) in place

Dimensions above ground 4' high. inches

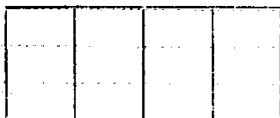

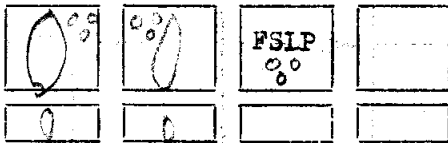

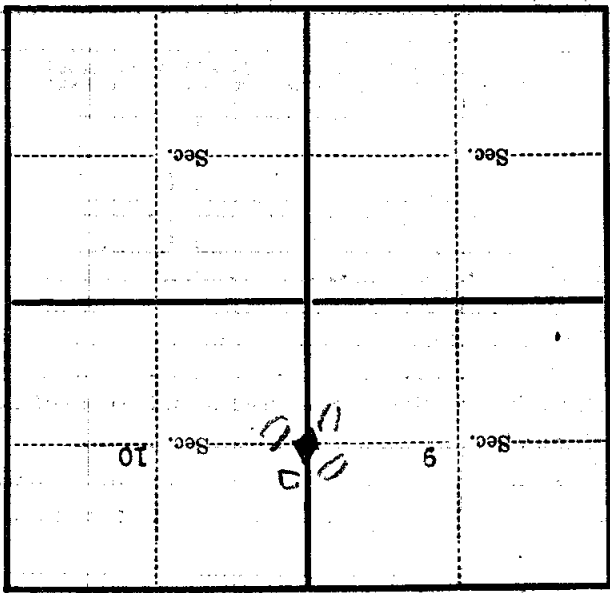
